Piggy graciously sat down with us to share her thoughts on aging, her romance with Kermie, and her thwarted Oscar ambitions.

**You've been in this business 35 years, yet you don't appear to have aged a day. What's your secret? Botox? Surgery?**

I was, as the saying goes, born this way: perfect. It's a gift, but one must take care of it each and every day—ideally with the help of a humongous team of stylists, personal trainers, doctors, lawyers, and other sycophants. When one begins at such a high level, one really doesn't need help—but I figure, why the heck not? Thus, over the years, moi has gone from merely flawless to an absolute humdinger.

I saw this not only as an opportunity to display my acting, but also as a way to acquire lots of new clothes and charge them to the production.

**What did you think of your co-stars, Jason Segel and Amy Adams?** Jason is marvelous, a true multihyphenate: actor-comedian-writer-tall guy. As for Ms. Adams, she and moi are *très* simpatico. We're both young, beautiful, talented—and we've both been stiffed by the Academy Awards. She has three nominations; moi has zip. Not that I'm counting. —MEGAN DEEM
